The United Sri Lankan Muslim Association of Australia (USMAA) has been in existence for 25 years since its inception on 22 December 1990. USMAA is a not-for-profit cultural, social, religious and humanitarian organisation, dedicated to the promotion of harmonisation, the Islamic religion, the SriLankan culture and the welfare of Sri Lankan Muslims across Australia.

The organisation is run entirely by volunteers within the community who are elected annually by USMAA members. All legal persons who belong to the Sri Lankan Muslim community and reside in Australia are eligible for Membership with the Association.
The major purpose of USMAA is to offer a cultural, social and religious space for the Sri Lankan Muslim community in Victoria to connect with each other and with the wider Australian community also.
To this end, USMAA has organised many Sports Days, Ladies' Nights, Trivia Nights, specific youth-targeted events, religious events, etc. Importantly, USMAA provides funeral services for Muslims in Victoria,
supporting families who require significant financial assistance in their time of need.

Organising various fundraising events and supporting many charities across Australia have remained a major focus for the organisation throughout its existence. Such charities include Alzheimer's Australia, the Breast Cancer Foundation, the Tsunami Appeal, the Redkite Appeal and many more. Furthermore, USMAA makes an active effort to participate in various multicultural events across Victoria in an effort to connect with the Australian community at large.

Moving into the next era, USMAA's priorities involve the construction of a community centre for youth and adults alike, in addition to increased collaboration with various organisations across Victoria to support community-focused fundraising initiatives.

USMAA now has a membership of over 400 people. With the continued support of USMAA members and the wider Australian community, the organisation will continue to grow and reach new heights.
