

USMAA lends a helping hand to financially struggling families in Sri Lanka



USMAA partnered with Bridging Lanka (NGO) to provide urgent aid to needy families in Mannar, Sri Lanka during Ramadan 2020. Thanks to the generous donations from the USMAA members, food rations were distributed to 31 Muslim villages in the Musali District in Mannar, Sri Lanka.

Bridging Lanka worked with the Divisional Secretariat to identify the families that required urgent assistance especially since the on-going pandemic affected their livelihoods. A majority of these families were led by widows and had differently abled children.

Each family received a pack of dry rations which included rice, dhal, flour, canned fish and other basic food items costing \$15 (per family).
