Dear members this might be one of the shortest reports JSC has ever presented but it has kept us busy especially with the on-set of the Covid19 virus.

On 29th January 2020 USMAA bid sad farewell to our Brother Deen Mohamed a dedicated member of the Association, the newly established USMAA Seniors, the local council volunteer work and the wider Sri Lankan Community activities - Inna lillahi wa inna ilaihi rajjoon.

On 30th March 2020 at the request of the ICV and to assist in the first Muslim Covid19 Janaza in Melbourne, a gravesite was provided by USMAA at the Fawkner Cemetery. The only other Covid19 Janaza was interred at Bunurong 3 weeks ago both expertly handled by Shiekh Ismail & co. of the Albanian Mosque Dandenong.

JSC have been busy with other janazas and of late assisted even Bro Abarakath Ali at ISOMER after receiving appeals as they presently don't have any volunteers to handle male janazas. We understand they even lost the services of the newly appointed Imam recently.

We're pleased to inform members that during the period under review we purchased 4 gravesites on 2/8/19

And 2 more on 9/6/20 in Bunurong Cemetery - avoiding the impending increases in the end of June.

In conclusion we're also pleased to inform that during the lockdown period JSC was able to distribute dry rations -received from the State Government & ICV and also food parcels collected from PGCC during the Month of Ramadan, mainly to international students and the elderly in Melbourne – Alhamdulillah.

We hope and pray that although there's been an increase in the Covid19 cases lately the authorities are able to bring it under control as soon as possible – In Shaa Allah Ameen
